The Northumberland Arts Council owns and operates the Fraser Gallery which is located in a beautiful historic building located at 362 Main Street in Tatamagouche. The Fraser Gallery includes three exhibition rooms, the Gallery Shop, the Lillian Fraser Gallery (Members Gallery) and the Visitor Information Centre. Since its beginning in 1981, the Northumberland Arts Council has supported the development of arts, crafts and culture on the North Shore.

## Completed applications may be submitted at any time throughout the year.

NOTE: January 31 is the deadline for shows the following summer. Artists will be notified early February.

We encourage early applications for 2024 by June 30.

## Proposal package shall contain:

1. Artist Biography, Statement and Curriculum Vitae

2. Description of exhibition.

3. Images of some work for the proposed exhibit (jpeg) and/or work in progress. You may include other relevant work as illustrative for your proposal. *Please send images in jpeg format, labeled: Artist name, title of work, size and medium.* 

4. Please indicate if this is for a solo exhibit or a group show.

5. Use the Gallery floor plan to determine how much space is available and how your work may fit. Determine the anticipated number of works with approximate sizes.

Final decision regarding assigned gallery will rest with the Gallery Committee.

NOTE: Most of the work must have been completed within the last 3 years and the majority of the work must not have been shown in the North Shore area. It is expected that the large majority of the work is available for purchase.
